TRACKING REGULATION CAUTIONARY DISCLAIMER

No dogs are allowed to be "off lead". Due to the changing nature of the fields
being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these
sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of
the tracking site.

MOTELS: There are many motels in the Lexington-Georgetown area that
are pet friendly. Please check for current pet requirements.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES: Due to Covid-19, we will consider all AKC,
local, state, and CDC guidelines for our tests. Anyone who does not
adhere to Covid-19 requirements will be asked to leave immediately.
Safety for all is our number one priority. As per our agreement with the
Horse Park and AKC guidelines we will not provide any food or drink,
PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, signed by the
actual owner or duly authorized agent and accompanied by appropriate entry fee
(separate checks for multiple entries) in US Funds. Please make checks payable to
Lexington Kennel Club. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Collection
fees will be added to the amount of each returned check. Entries will be
acknowledged if a legible email address is included on the entry form. Do not send
entries by any method which requires a signature for acceptance. **Cancellation of
entries must be made in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries.**

A worker draw will be used for these tests in accordance with the parameters set forth
in Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations. 1 track will be set aside for
workers, in the TDX test.

In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations, entries shall be accepted up until
the official closing date even though the advertised limit has been reached. A random
drawing of all entries with preference given to dogs which have not previously earned
the applicable AKC tracking title to determine catalog order will take place on February
6, 2020 at 6 PM EST, at 1151 Venetian Way, Lexington, KY and the public is invited.
When the limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn in the same
manner and assigned a position on the alternate list. In the event the advertised limit
is not reached, entries will be assigned catalog numbers in the order in which they
were received and a draw will not take place.

All entries will be notified of their entry status and a Judging Program will be emailed
and/or mailed to the entrant as soon as practical after entries close and the draw is
completed. Should you not receive such notification within a reasonable amount of
time, please contact the Event Secretary.

**Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do
not run and entrants replaced by an alternate at the test. Entry fees will be
refunded within seven (7) days following the test date if an SASE has been
provided by the entrant; otherwise, the checks will be shredded.** In the event an
accepted entry withdraws prior to the test date, the event secretary shall contact
alternates according to their placement on the alternate list and upon notification, said
alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in
the test.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are
free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have
appropriate vaccinations.

The Lexington Kennel Club, its officers and representatives, the Event
Chair, Secretary, Committee and the owner(s) of the Event site(s) assume no

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
